ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

Maharaja Sansar Chand Memorial (MSCM) College, Thural, Dist Kangra (HP) recognized under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956, is a constituent college of Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. It was established in the year 1978 in the very rural area under the then Tehsil Palampur. It was named after Maharaja Sansar Chand (c. 1765--1824) (r. 1775--1823) who was an 18th-century Katoch dynasty ruler who revived Kangra's power,



becoming the dominant "Emperor of the Hills". It is now in the Indian state of Himachal Pradesh. He was a scion of the Katoch dynasty, which ruled Kangra for centuries until they were ousted by the Mughals in the early 17th century. In 1758, Sansar Chand's grandfather, Ghamand Chand, was appointed governor of Jalandhar by Ahmed Shah Abdali. Sansar Chand rallied an army, ousted the Mughal governor of Kangra, Saifu Ali Khan

Kaymkhani, and regained possession of his patrimony. Sansar Chand did a lot of work for the welfare of people mainly residing in nearby places apart from Kangra like Palampur, Hamirpur. He built many water distributaries. One of them is near this college known as *Naun*. The water was used for farming and livestock.

This college was a privately managed, and then it was taken over by the Govt of Himachal Pradesh in 2005. It has all the traditional streams like BA, BSc & BCom and an employment-oriented course BCA.

This college strives to create an environment conducive to continuous academic and co-curricular activities and holistic development of students as well as staff members. For this purpose, constituent efforts have always been made by all the stakeholders to foster, encourage and motivate ideas and try to put them in to practice. College also tries to inculcate all the values enshrined in our constitution, the values of liberty, equality, justice and brotherhood. We encourage a sense of tolerance for different cultures and opinions among our students.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

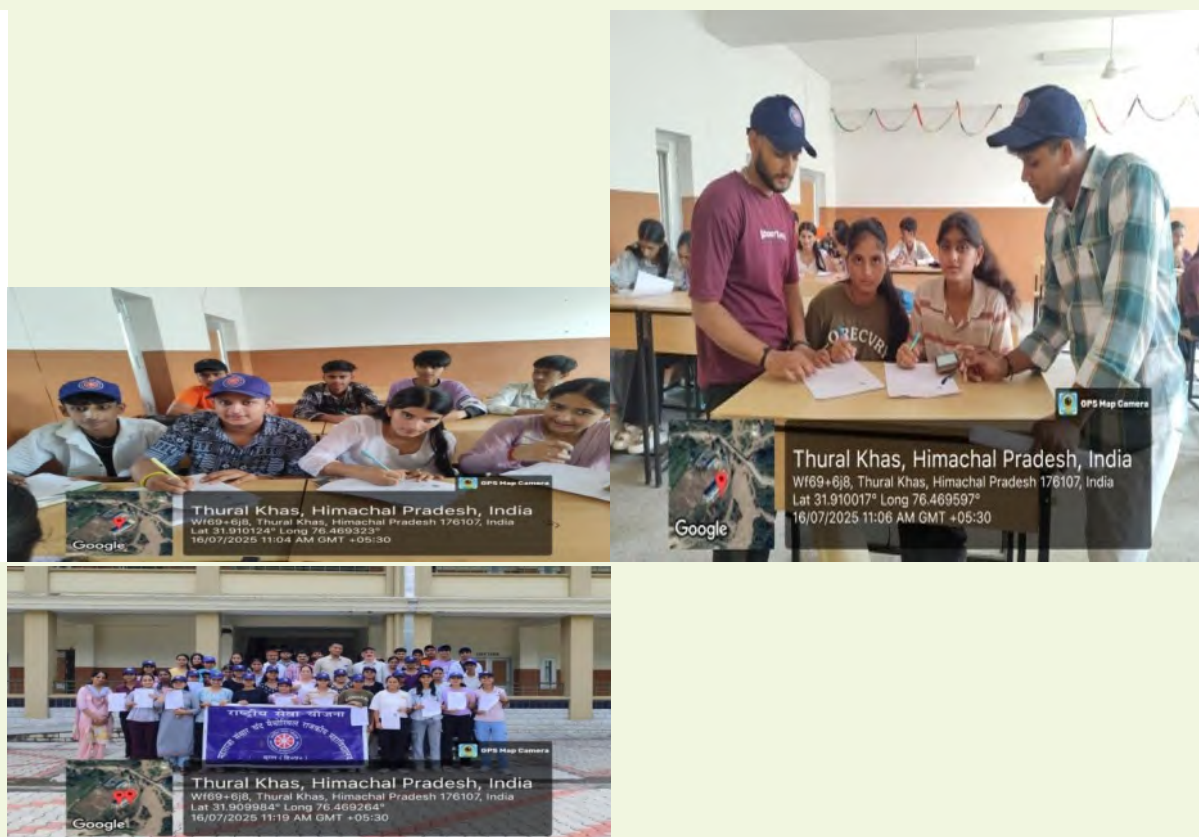
NSS

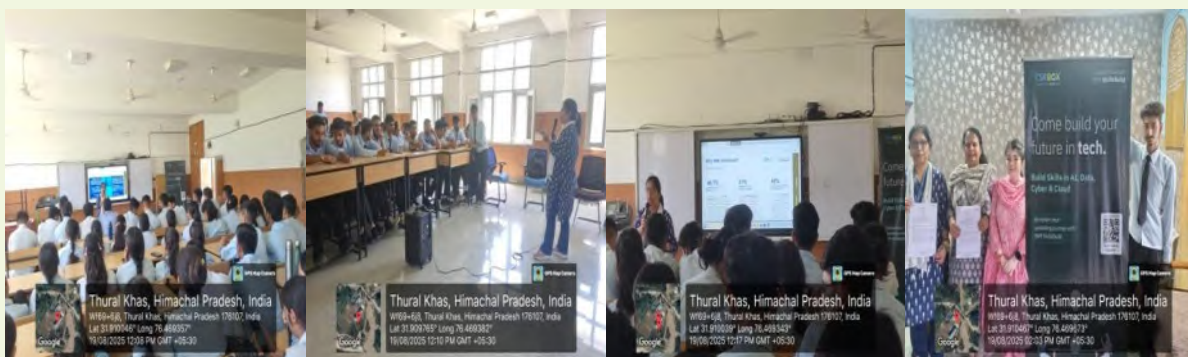

CONDUCTING ONLINE CLASSES



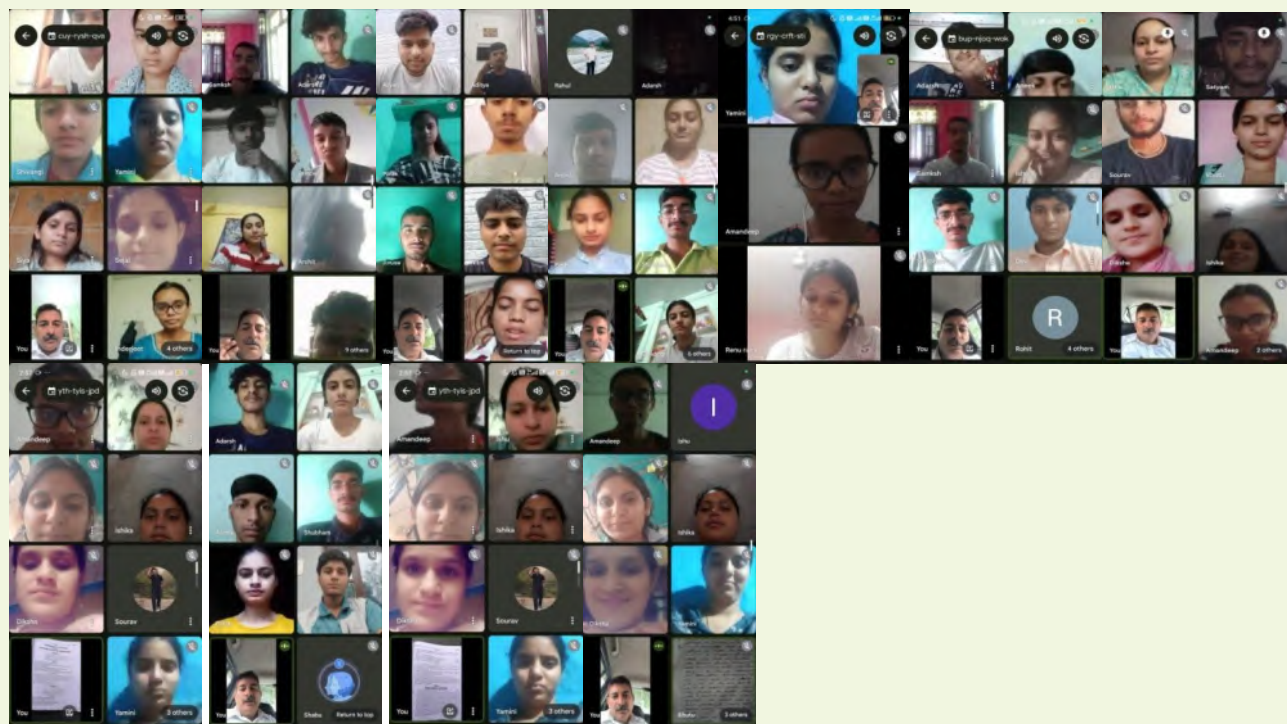

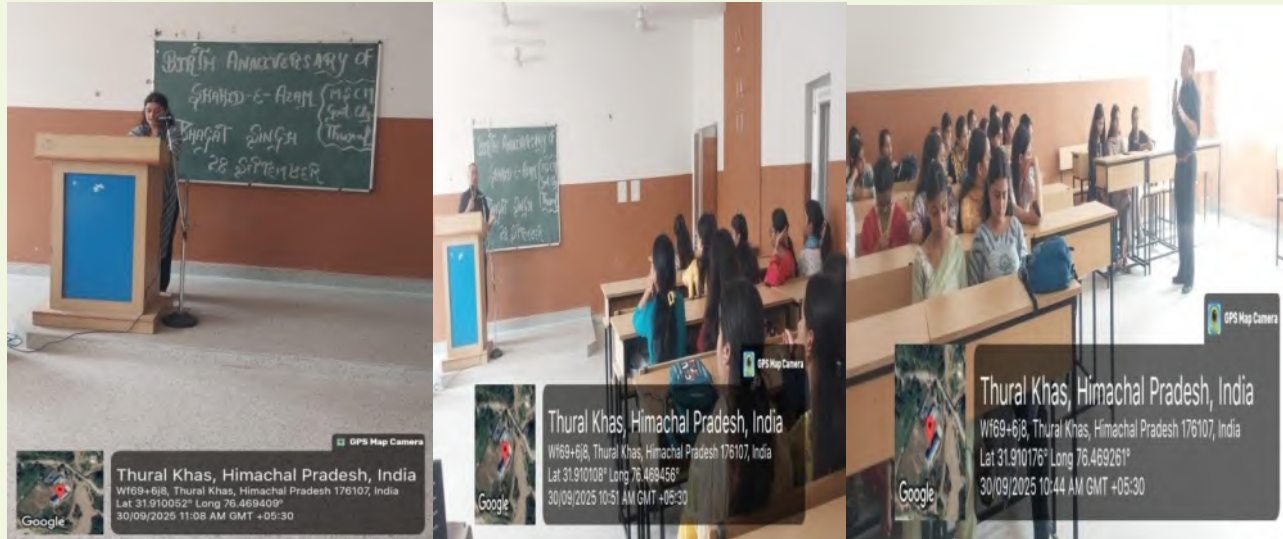

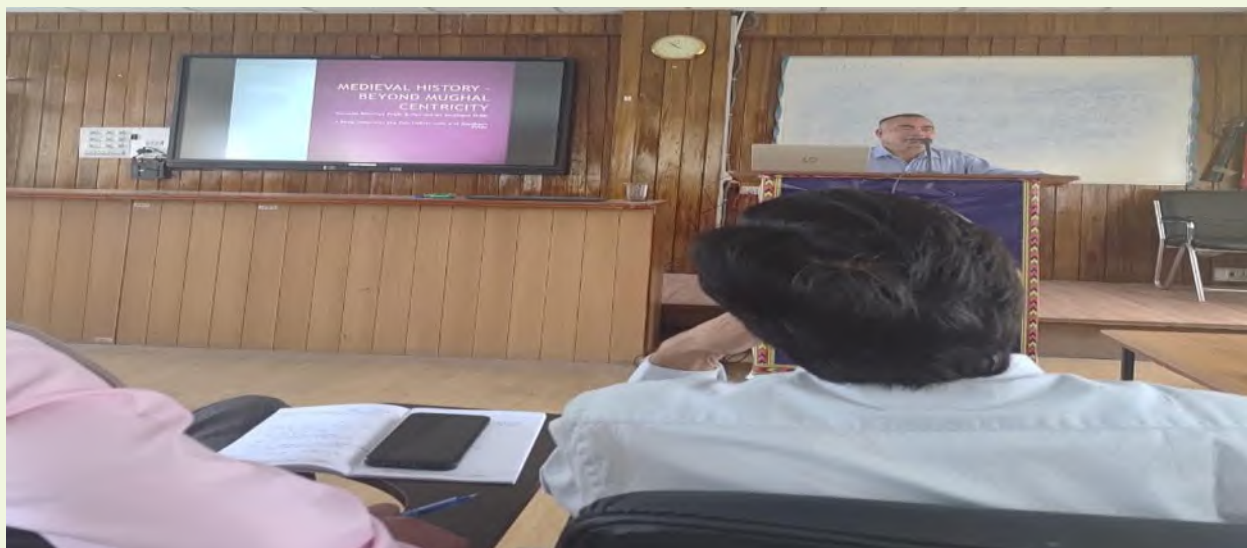


- 7) The Constitution Day was celebrated on 26 November 2025.
